



In English, we will be learning about the features of a narrative quest. We will be reading Odd and the Frost Giants and then creating our own narrative about a character's quest.

In Art and Design, we will be learning to use the running stitch to sew our own purses. We will also be designing and creating our own sword hilts.

In Maths, our topic is Multiplication and Division. We will be looking at how to use the short multiplication and division method. We will be investigating multiples of a number, finding factor pairs and calculating square numbers. Please support your child by allowing them to use TtRockstars, in order to develop their times table knowledge.

This half term our guided reading comprehension focus is Inference. We will be learning to make judgements about the text using evidence and clues, from the text, to support our answer.

In science, we will be investigating the effects of conductors and insulators. We will also be looking at reversible and irreversible changes.

For our history topic, we will be looking at when, how and why the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings invaded Britain. We will be learning about how village life differs from everyday life today.

In Geography, we will be developing our map skills to identify Viking homelands and settlements.

On the 16th January, we will be visited by the Vikings.

In RE our new topic is Mission. We will be looking at the mission of the church and our part in God's mission.
