- Narrative- We will be writing our own journey story about escaping a disaster.




Mathematics

- Multiplication- We will use our times tables knowledge to learn how to answer 3 digit by 1 digit questions.
- Measure- We will learn how to use different units of measure and apply this to our learning.

- Community- We will describe how it feels to be part of a community, the responsibilities it entails and the characteristics of those who are a part of the church community.
- Giving and Receiving- We will learn about the importance of giving and receiving, focussing on the Eucharist, the Penitential Act and the Communion Rite.
- Self- Discipline- We will look at the importance of Lent and the Easter Story.

- We will learn all about the impact of the Romans and Greeks on life today.
- We will learn all about how the Roman and Greek ways of life.

Geography

- We will look at the growth of the Roman Empire and the countries the Empire spanned.
