**Out of the Egg**

This term will see us finding some eggs at school and investigating what comes out of them. Here's what we will be learning about in the next 6 weeks.

**How to support your child further:**

- **Talk with your child about what is happening at school - encourage them to use their imagination!**
- **Continue to learn their letter sounds.**
- **Continue to practise addition and subtraction problem and talk about how they solved them.**

**Literacy:**

- Using the sounds they know to sound out words and write labels and sentences.
- Using books to research what type of egg it could be.

**Maths:**

- Addition and subtraction problems - using various ways to work out the answers
- Weighing objects to find the heaviest and lightest

**RE:**

- Celebrating - how the parish and family celebrate.
- Gathering - the joy of gathering together to listen to God's word.

**Personal, Social and Emotional Development:**

- Negotiating and solving problems
- Say when they do and don't need help

**Communication, Language and Literacy:**

- Responding to instructions
- Listen to ideas expressed by others
- Uses talk to organise and sequence thinking, feels and events.

**Physical Development:**

- Forming letters correctly.
- Climbing over and under objects safely and with co-ordination

**Knowledge and understanding of the world:**

- Looking at textures - describing how something feels
- Life cycle of a chicken
- Using the internet to research what comes out of an egg.
